



Angela Rodriquez

February 24, 1954 - June 23, 2020

Angela Suzzette Rodriquez, 66, passed away on Tuesday, June 23, 2020. Known as Angie to her friends and family, she was a lifelong Henryetta resident and local businesswoman. Born February 24, 1954, she was the fourth child and second daughter of Gregory and Lois Baird Rodriquez. Memorial services are Monday, June 29, 2 p.m., at the Rogers Funeral Home Chapel, with Pastor Timothy Cole officiating.

Angie was preceded in death by her parents, one brother, Gregory Rodriquez, Jr., one sister, Estelita Marie Rodriquez, and her beloved sister-in-law, Vickie Becker Rodriquez. She is survived by three brothers, Stephen Rodriquez of Henryetta, Francisco (Frank) Rodriquez of Norman, and Vincent Rodriquez of Columbia, MO. Also surviving are two nieces, Ginger Rodriquez of Sand Springs and Jessica Rodriquez McClain of Moore, and one nephew, Richard Rodriquez of Norman. She is also survived by several great nieces and nephews.

A 1972 graduate of Henryetta High School, Angie spent several years as an employee of St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa, where she was a phlebotomist and lab technician. After leaving her healthcare career, she spent many years working for the Oklahoma Citizen, a weekly newspaper in Henryetta.

She was a long-time member of the Henryetta First Church of the Nazarene, where her memorial service will be held. Burial services are provided by Rogers Funeral Home of Henryetta.

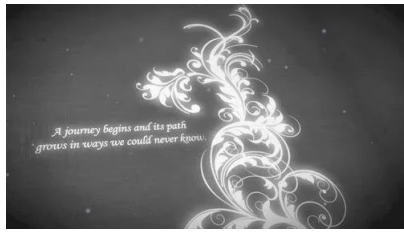

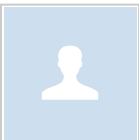
