She was only a little over 2 yrs. older than me & (as Grandma always called me her oldest Grandchild & youngest child) we were together a lot growing up. I have so many memories; playing in the neighborhood at Grandma's, going to the little store by them (Blake's), being scared of 'the mean lady who lived on the corner' (lol), walking to the Girl Scout house after school together (in those days that was safe) or to piano lessons & swimming at the old lake together (& taking swim lessons). I was so proud when she asked me to be in her wedding & wanted me to be there when Mike was born & she was having trouble & was scared. Every year when the State Fair came to Tulsa Grandma & Daddy or Momma would take us out of school to see the Ice Capades & usually the Circus - I always loved that day! She was always so giving to everyone. When I had Cody she hand-made a entire baby bed set (I still have the quilt). We did a lot together & when she would visit in Tx we would often take our kids to Six Flags & always managed to get lost coming home-I'm sure it was her fault! lol I haven't gotten to visit her nearly as much as I would've liked to in these last years, but as we get older & move away that tends to happen I guess. But we have kept in touch thru the phone calls - usually really long calls! (& if you knew Cathy you know most all conversations with her were long! =*}) I was fortunate to have a 2 hr call with her about a week before this last episode & I'm grateful for that, but that was not enough! I have so many memories flooding my mind now, but there's no way to mention them all. But they will always be in my heart along with my love for her. I love you too John, you've been a great Uncle for the past 44 years & will be for much longer. Cathy could not have had a husband who loved her more or who would have taken better care of her than you did! I'm here if you need anything & I love you & thank you! Stacey & Mike, your Mother was so very proud of you & loved you more than you will ever know! I love you both, please call me if you need to! But most of all Cathy, I know how much you've suffered these last years & I hated that & I know how tired

Knowing you were there & having our talks meant so much to me & I know you loved me.
