John Charles “Chuck” Kerr was born Friday, January 6, 1961 in Henryetta, Oklahoma. He passed from this life on November 25, 2018 in Tulsa, Ok, at the age of 57. Chuck was a baptized believer and had great faith. 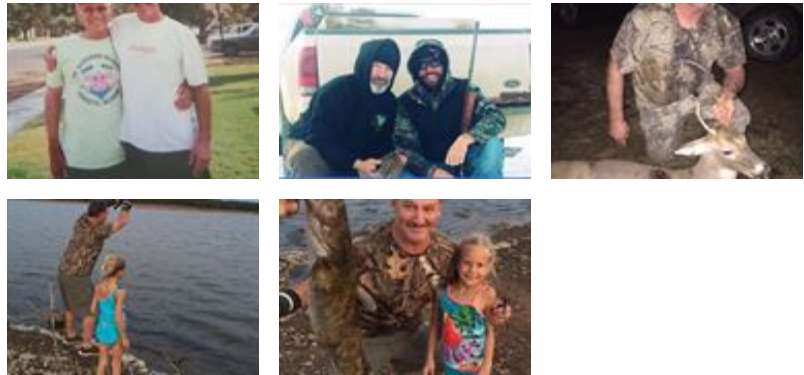
