Dale L Warner was taken home to the Lord on December 6, 2015. He was born in Lebanon, NE at home on January 18, 1944 to Harry Warner and Aril Ankenman, He was 71 years old.

Dale grew up in Lebanon where he graduated from Beaver Valley HS in 1963. He was united in marriage to Sharron Blickenstaff of Wilsonville, NE on September 18, 1964. They made their home west of Wilsonville until 1967 when they moved south of Hendley to farm. In 1983 they moved to Lebanon, NE where he worked for 3 Oaks Heating and plumbing in McCook, NE. In 1986 Dale and Sharron become over the road team truck drivers until 1993 when they moved to Bozeman, MT where Dale continued to drive truck. Dale and Sharon then moved to Weleetka, OK in 1997 where they raised cattle and he continued driving trucks. In 2005 he retired and remained on the ranch until his death. They were married 51 years.

Dale was a member of the Weleetka Baptist Church. He enjoyed many things in life, such as hunting, motorcycling, shooting black powder, going to the lake to name a few but most of all he enjoyed his family and friends.
