She retired from the Quilt Barn in 2020 after a serious fall and other health issues. Elreda leaves behind her two most prize accomplishments in life. Her family and a nice business which thrived for many years and many fond memories of the friends she made at the Quilt Barn; and many beautiful quilts to share with customers, family and friends.

Elreda loved her children, her home with a beautiful yard and many many flowers. She was very proud of making a successful business doing what she loved to do: Quilting, and going to antique auctions. Her business was featured on TV a few times; Discover Oklahoma featured her business twice. She was also featured in many quilting articles' and magazines.

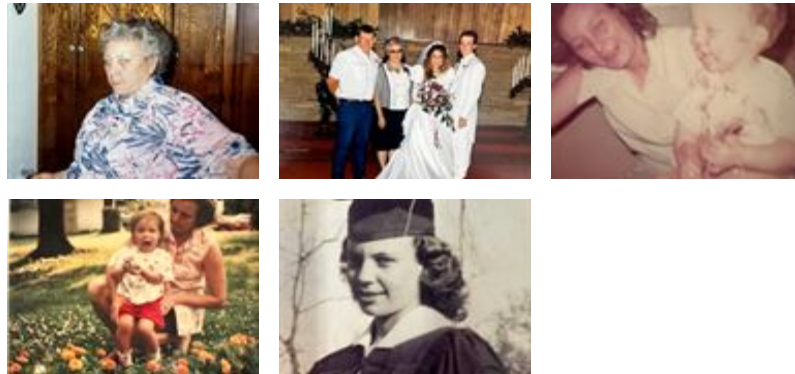

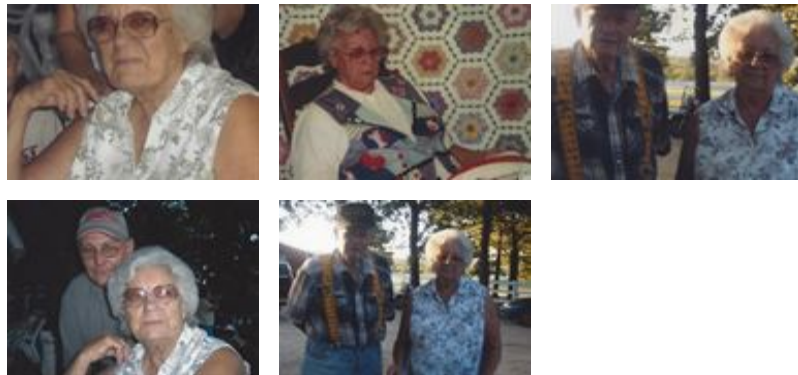
