Born on February 17, 1952, in Henryetta to Melvin and Pauline (Wynn) Williams, Hank dedicated much of his life to service. He worked at the Henryetta Fire Department and later continued his commitment to helping others by volunteering with the Dustin Fire Department and then retiring from his fire fighting duties.. 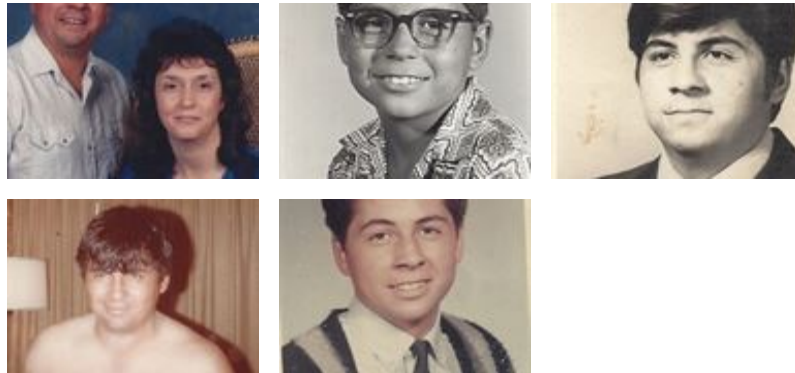
