James D Jones was born on May 3, 1937 in Pharoah, Ok to James and Lena Mae Jones. He passed this life on November 11, 2020 in Yukon, Ok at the age of 83. 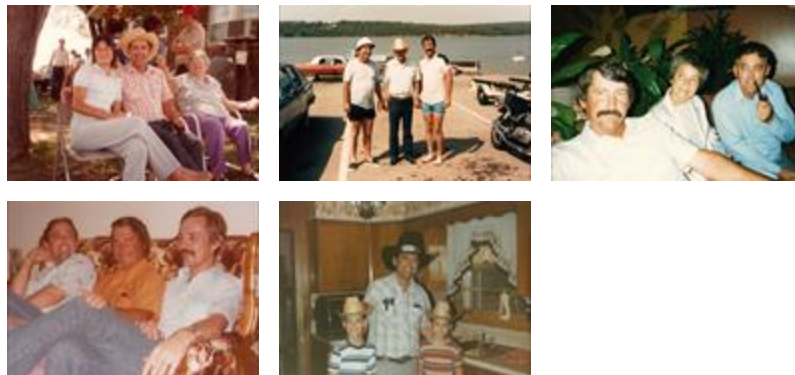
