JoElla Carson a resident of Tulsa, OK passed this life on July 5, 2024 in Tulsa at the age of 86. Born November 19, 1937 in Henryetta, Ok to Clarence “Kit” and Letha (Edwards) Carson.

JoElla graduated from the Hillcrest Medical Center of Nursing in 1959 as a registered nurse. She worked at the Hissom Memorial Center as the acting lead nurse. She then went back to the Hillcrest Medical Center and worked in the Post Surgery and General medical units. She entered the Oklahoma Air National Guard as a Chief Flight Nurse achieving the rank of Major while maintaining a full time civilian job while serving the Air National Guard. She also worked in the Psychology unit at Jew’s Hospital in St Louis, MO and later in the Intensive Care unit.
