Joe Max Peavler a resident of Henryetta passed this life on April 9, 2026. Born March 31, 1938 in the Salem Community to Louis and Odane (Johnson) Peavler.

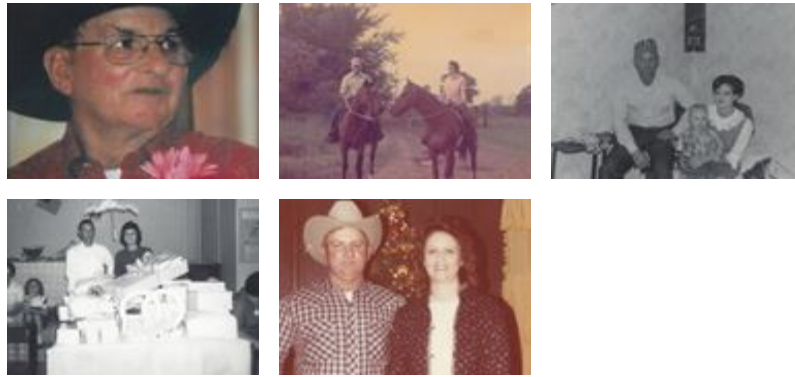
