Jo Thompson, age 96, passed away January 4, 2019. She was born in El Reno, OK to Frank Schott and Katherine Schlauder Schott. Her family moved from Germany to Oklahoma in the early 1900's. Jo attended school in El Reno and then moved to Oklahoma City to attend St. Anthony's School of Nursing. She worked as an RN for many years.

On December 26, 1950 she married Red Thompson and they made Henryetta their home. They had two daughters Vicki and Pam. Jo and Red built what was to become one of Henryetta's most notable icons, the IN & OUT Drive-in. They owned and operated the IN & OUT until 1977. After retirement Jo devoted her time to family, especially grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Jo recently said, "I have had a wonderful life, wonderful family and wonderful friends."

Jo is preceded in death by her parents, beloved husband of 68 years Red Thompson, one brother and four sisters.
