Marcus Edward "ED" Hall, 91, of Henryetta, Oklahoma passed away thursday, May 19,2011 at Hospice of Wichita Falls following a short illness.

Ed was born on September 24,1919 in Colleyville, Texas to the late William Houston and Alice (Turner) Hall.

Following his childhood near Paducah, Texas he moved to Henryetta Oklahoma where he met and married Ruby E. Coody on August 16,1940. In 1947, they were blessed with their only son, Marcus Edward Hall II. He moved to Burkburnett in 2008 to be closer to his family.

Ed worked in the metal business at Eagle Pitcher Smelters for 27 years and then for John Zinc Co of Tulsa as a drill press operator.
