She was a homemaker most of her life raising her children and following their interests throughout their younger years, often times being volunteered for many field trips. She was an avid horse enthusiast. She began dabbling in barrel racing but quickly realized her real love lay in competitive trail riding. 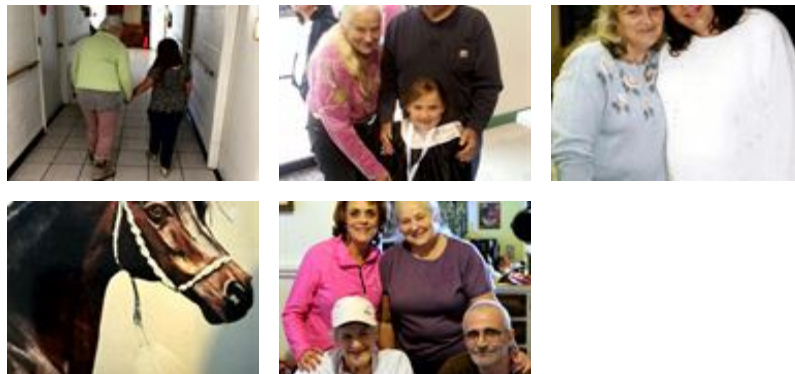
