With profound sadness and heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Preston James McKinney, age 53, of Houston, Texas. Born in Midwest City, Oklahoma, on February 24, 1972 and passed away on May 26, 2025.

A proud member of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, Preston carried his heritage with pride and embodied the values of strength, resilience, and deep familial loyalty.

He was preceded in death by his beloved mother, Sandy (Rule) McKinney, and his brother, Travis McKinney, both of whom he held close in memory. He is survived by his father, Earl McKinney, and stepmother Marilyn McKinney; his three children: Marina Roark (Austin), Jordan McKinney, and Alyssa McKinney; and his beloved grandsons: Emerson, Callum, and Beckham Roark.

Preston is also survived by his siblings: Steven McKinney, Russell McKinney, and Ashli McKinney (Heather Chambers); as well as numerous nieces, nephews, extended family members, and a wide circle of friends who became family over the years.

Preston will be remembered for his love of motorcycles, especially Harley-Davidson. He often referred to his rides as “wind therapy,” finding freedom and

peace on the open road. A diehard fan of Houston sports teams, he never missed watching a game.

Although he was born and raised in Oklahoma, Preston's heart belonged to Texas on game days. You could always count on him to root for the Texas Longhorns, especially against the Sooners. As Preston would proudly say: "Hook 'em Horns!"

He loved fishing on his family property in Oklahoma, a pastime that he later taught his grandson Emerson. He was counting down the days until Callum and Beckham could bait a hook.

Preston lived with grit, humor, and deep affection for the people he loved. His stories, spirit, and steady presence will be missed more than words can express—but his legacy lives on in every ride, every cast, every cheer, and every memory.

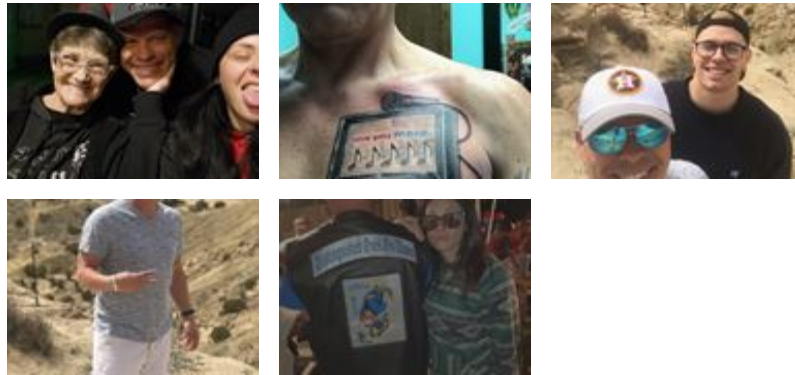
