In high school Rick split his time between riding bulls in the rodeo arena and playing the position of guard on the football field. His ability on the football field afforded him a full ride scholarship offer from the University of Tulsa. After spending a year at TU Rick opted to join the trucking industry and earn a living seeing the sights of North America as he traversed the highways of the US and Canada. 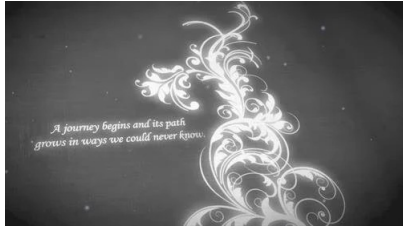
Rick is preceded in death by his father, Richard Reavis. His brother Randy Reavis. His father in law Don Rose, and his mother in law Maudie Rose.

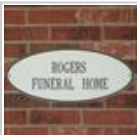
