Robert Lee Barnett, a resident of Henryetta, passed this life on March 1, 2022 at the age of 92. He was born September 20, 1929 in Saratoga, Arkansas to Grover and Artie(Yates) Barnett. He married Rose DeColbert on March 31, 1948. He proudly served his country and was a WWII Veteran.

He held many jobs including a butcher at Square Deal grocery store, Miner in Colorado and New Mexico, Industrial Radiographer working on the Northwest Alaskan pipeline, and owner of Barnett Storage.

He was a Master Mason of 53 years, a member the Oklahoma Eastern Star, The Scottish Rite and a Shriner. He served on Henryetta City Council and was on the Housing Authority Board.
