



Robert "Bob" Cunningham

July 17, 1937 - December 30, 2021

Longtime resident and former owner of "Bob's" Clothiers passed this life on December 30, 2021 at the age of 84. Born July 17, 1937 to John and Mollie Mae (Little) Cunningham. Bob and his wife June founded Bob's clothiers in 1962 and later partnered with Rick Thompson, retiring in 2000. He was on the Board of Directors for the American Exchange Bank, Past President of the Henryetta Chamber of Commerce, long time member of the Henryetta First Baptist Church, and one of the faithful Shoney Coffee Club Members. 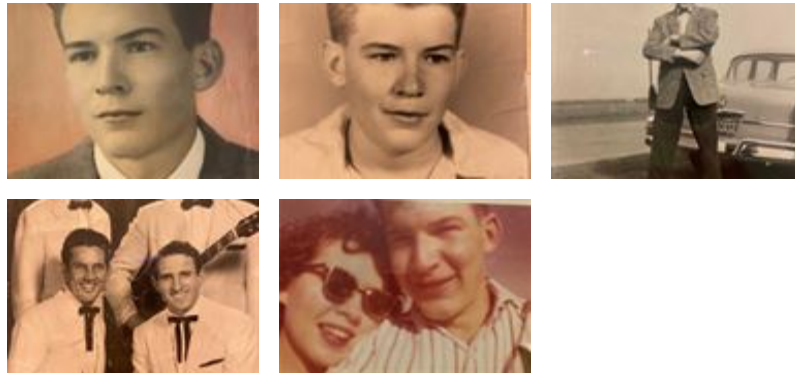
