Robert “Bob” Keesee a resident of Henryetta passed away on November 30, 2015 in Henryetta at the age of 79. Born October 24, 1936 in Corpus Christie, TX to Peter Martin and Mary (Holtzclaw) Keesee. Bob is well known in the community of Henryetta as a barber. He worked earlier at PPG and then taught school in Wetumka and retired from Schuler Public Schools. 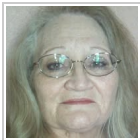
