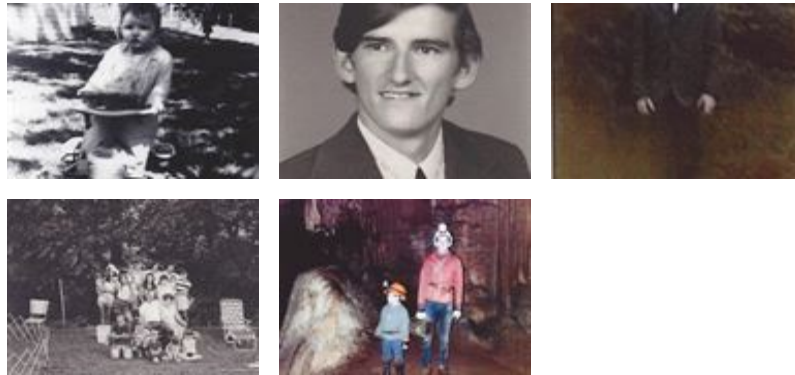
He and I talked many times over the last 12 years and I will miss his stories and his music. Take care Terry, my friend, may you rest in peace.

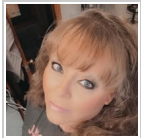
