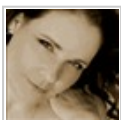

Tony was the love of my life! He will be forever in my heart! I am his "FOREVER GIRL" and he was my "KNIGHT IN SHINING RECYCLED TIN FOIL" that's what called himself. He also called himself my "Man-tard" He touched my life in ways no one has ever before and never will again! We weren't married, but I feel like I lost my husband and life partner! I feel like I spent a life-time with him over the course of a year and three months that we got together.

When I was nine and he was ten, I showed up at Grandfield Elementary School. He saw me in the hallway. He said an angel had walked into his life that day, and he fell in love. Everyone in that school called him "Booger-nose Tony" except for me. I loved him when I was nine. We spent as much time together as his mom and dad would allow. We rode the Joy Bus together to church on Sundays and sat together all the time. We would meet at the school and play on the playground. One day, I wrote in the front of his Bible that I loved him, and that we would one day be married. I also wrote that I would NEVER break up with him, and that we would always be together.

People today tell me that kids of that age cannot and could not possibly be in love. I tell them, "WE were in love!!!!"

One day, I had to tell him that I was moving. We cried because we were never going to see each other again. He told me that he asked his mom and dad if they could move to Electra, TX, that is where I was moving to. Of course, that never happened. We lost touch for 34 1/2 years. Then, sometime in September of 2010, I had a package come across my hands at work with a name "Tony Clement" I about dropped to my knees because I thought this was HIM!!!! My heart was pounding, and I almost wrote to this person to see if it was him. I had remembered his name incorrectly. On October 30, 2010, I received a message on Facebook from Tony asking me if my sister and I ever attended church in Grandfield, and many other things. He continued on with his story of his quest to find me over the years. I responded to this message with the story of how the kids in school teased him and how I had written in his Bible to confirm that it definitely was me!

He said he was crying when he wrote me the message because he just knew that this time it really was ME! I was shaking when I wrote my message. I sent him my phone number, and within a few minutes of receiving my message, he called. We spoke for about three hours. He didn't understand why we talked for such a long time because he said he hated talking on the phone, yet every time we spoke on the phone, we rarely spoke for less than 30 minutes. The rest is history! I never got to see him in person as I live in Arizona and he lived in Oklahoma, but that did not matter. I am in love with him because of who he is, not for what he looked like or how much or little money he had. He always told me he felt I deserved better than him, but I told him, HE IS THE BEST MAN IN THE WHOLE WIDE WORLD!!!! I would call and ask him, "How's the sexiest man in Okmulgee?" His response was, "When I see him, I'll ask." He was referring to his best friend, Shawn Michael Pitt. LOL!!!! He was always trying to make others laugh in spite of his own heartache. He always made me laugh!!!!
